- Cost is \$4 per entry.

ENTRY DROP-OFF:

- All entries should be dropped off at the Johnson County Museum of History on the morning of the show, Saturday, August 28, 2021 from 8:30am – 10:30am.

- Easels and tables will be provided by the Franklin Parks & Recreation Department. If you have an easel you wish to use, you are more than welcome to do so.

ENTRY PICK-UP:

- All entries should be picked up at the Johnson County Museum of History between 3:00pm – 4:00pm on the day of the event. Artwork will be released by event staff to insure each artist receives their artwork.

SHOW:

- Judging will take place on the morning of the show. Late entries will not be accepted.
- The Art Show will be open to the public from 12:00pm – 3:00pm.
- Tri Kappa People's Choice Awards (youth category and adult category) will be given. Each People's Choice winner receives \$50. Voting for these awards will take place the day of the show from 12:00pm – 2:45pm.
